Show hours are 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Thursday, Friday and Saturday, and 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on Sunday. The Show is open to the general public. Children 14 years old and younger are free with a paying adult.

Booths are all 10' in depth and vary from 10' to 50' in length. Booths are equipped with three-foot side drapes and an eight-foot back drape. Booth inventory also includes a sign, tables and chairs (number dependent on the size of the booth).

Jr. Education Table: Open during Show hours starting at 2:00 p.m. on Friday, February 11th through the close of the Show at 5:00 p.m. on Sunday, February 13th. Members of the Society of Earth Sciences Students from The University of Arizona, staff the Jr. Education Table. Donations of mineral samples suitable for splitting and handing out are always appreciated.

School Visits Program: Friday, February 11th from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon. The Show opens at 9:00 a.m. to the school children only! The general public is admitted beginning at 10:00 a.m. This is another very popular program, and it succeeds because of the support of the Dealers and Exhibitor-Dealers in our Show. The Dealers also interact with the children by answering questions and providing demonstrations.
